#### **PASTOR'S PONDERINGS!**



For those of you who were not in church on July 23, I'd like to share with you my words on that day.....In the past couple weeks my health has taken some unexpected turns for the worse and I am finding myself faced with the distinct possibility that those health issues may shorten my time in full-time service to God's church. That, along with my husband, Dennis' decline in health and mobility, we have come to the conclusion that it is finally time for me to retire.

As it stands at this present moment, September 30, 2023, I would be concluding my position as interim Pastor at American Lutheran Church, Rantoul, IL. I know this is not the most ideal situation, and I know that there were hopes that this could be a long term position, but health concerns are first and foremost in my heart and mind. In light of that and to help reduce the level of stress and work load, your church council and I have agreed that from this time on, I would lead Sunday morning worship, bury the dead, marry couples, and baptize, and continue to visit those hospitalized and special and emergency circumstances.

My time at here at American has been relatively short, but full of grace, blessings, learning and understanding. I will miss you, especially missing all the wonderful hugs the most. I'll forever be grateful for this congregation and the warm welcome I felt when I first came here last November.

You will be receiving this newsletter during the time I had set aside a while ago for vacation time. Dennis and I are spending some restful time with daughter Amilyn and family: grandson time!! And I'm reminded of how I used to love to take to the open road during the summer. When I was a child, every August we would pack up the car and go. Sometimes it was just to some destination in our home state of Wisconsin; but about every 4 years we'd be off to the distant land of Montana! I remember those trips very well. In 1959, we passed through Yellowstone National Park the day of the earthquake! We were to have stopped and camped that night, but my dad decided that it was early enough in the day that we would head up to my sister's in Helena, Montana. Lucky for us we did, since the camp ground where we were going to stay, the next day was a lake! Or maybe I should say, how blessed we were that my dad made that decision.

We learned that day, that taking to the open road is always an adventure because of the uncertainty that lies ahead. Perhaps that's part of what makes summer vacations in the car so memorable. Who could forget an earthquake, engine trouble in the badlands or navigating a road washed out from a summer thunder storm?

The Bible speaks of life as a road or path that we are called to travel, such as.....

- 1) Matthew 7:17, "Small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life and only a few find it."
- 2) Acts 2:28, "You have made known to me the paths of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence."
- **3)** Romans 11:33, "Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable his judgments, and his paths beyond tracing out!"
- **4) 2 Corinthians 6:3,** "We put no stumbling block in anyone's path, so that our ministry will not be discredited."
- **5) John 14:6,** "Jesus said, 'I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

We often find that the road of life is narrow, is not easy to find, and is sometimes mysterious. It can teach us many things, like to care for others. Our life-long journeys should always begin with knowing Jesus is the way to our ultimate destination.... heaven and life everlasting with our Lord!

This is a very exciting, although somewhat challenging, time for American Lutheran and I hope and pray you take the time to be with your brothers and sisters here at church during this journey with all its adventures and uncertainties with the knowledge that you have a great companion on the journey with you; Jesus Christ!!! May His peace go with us all!
