Grace and Peace to you all, Merry Christmas and a happy New Year,

I'm overjoyed to be writing this first newsletter article. The opportunity to serve as Pastor at American Lutheran Church is a great blessing to my family and me. She is a Board-Certified Music Therapist with a M.A. Music Therapy from St. Mary of the Woods College in Terre Haute Indiana. CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES

NOVEMBER 19, 2024

The call committee has recommended we put a call in for Aaron Dawson as our new pastor. Questions were asked and answered by some council members. Additional Agenda Items and Approval of Agenda - Motion by Shirley Friemel to approve agenda, second by Linda Kirk. Motion carried. The council unanimously accepted recommendation from the call committee. Motion was made by Ron Howe, seconded by Lois Sjoken to hold a congregational meeting on Sunday, December 1st, to call Aaron Dawson to be the pastor at American Lutheran Church. Motion carried. Approval of Past Meeting Minutes – Motion to approve by Deanne Rosenbeck, second by Marleen Peavler. Motion carried.

<u>Treasurer's Report/Financial Committee Report</u>

DeAnn McMorris reported that at the 84% timeline of our budget, we have used 64% of it. She said we need to get projects completed, billed and submitted before the year end. New phone system

installed and working well, new emergency lights and signs have been installed. Waiting on equipment for internet installation for parsonage. Seeking quotes for insurance as we will be getting a \$6000 dollar increase from current insurance company. Revenue right now is not meeting expenditures, but this is usually made up in the month of December. Approval was given to DeAnn to use the church bus for the Rantoul Christmas parade representing the Canteen Run.

Motion to adjourn by Ron Howe, second by Devin Cox, motion carried. Adjourned at 8:48 p.m. Closed with the Lord's Prayer.


